REAL ID Extended to May 7, 2025

The Department of Homeland Security extended the REAL ID deadline to May 7, 2025. The REAL ID Act established minimum security standards for state-issued driver's licenses and identification cards and prohibits Federal agencies from accepting for official purposes licenses and identification cards from states that do not meet these standards. Beginning May 7, 2025, every state and territory resident will need to present a REAL ID compliant license/ID, or another acceptable form of ID for boarding commercial aircraft, accessing Federal facilities and entering nuclear plants. The Transportation Security Administration (TSA) considers a current passport or military ID acceptable identification for boarding an aircraft. Porch pirates primed to take packages

Steps to protect you from thieves lurking neighborhoods

Cyber Monday kicks off the busy season for more than just online retailers and delivery services. It also opens high season for porch pirates.

Of course, thieves who steal packages from homes operate year-round, but they're particularly active during the holidays. If you order gifts online, you risk becoming one of their victims. But there are ways to protect your purchases, including:

Have your packages delivered to a secure location – Many retailers allow you to opt for in-store pickup when you order online. You also can have packages sent to a UPS store or U.S. Postal Service (USPS) office, designated brick-and-mortar retailers, or to an Amazon Locker facility. Your apartment complex's leasing office also might accept packages.

Sign up for delivery alerts – Some retailers will send you an email or text when your package is dropped off, and most delivery services have apps that allow you to track packages. That way, you can make sure you are home to receive the package or you can ask a neighbor to collect it for you.

Install a security camera – A front-door camera alone might discourage

package pirates. Even if it doesn't, it will record the theft and give you evidence to bolster any claim you make.

Place a lockbox at your doorstep – This large container can be bolted to your property. After placing a package inside, a delivery person can secure it

with a combination lock. If a package is stolen, you have a few avenues for resolution, including:

Contact the retailer who sold you the item – Many sellers will provide a replacement or refund if you call customer service and explain what

happened.

File a claim with the delivery service – If the retailer doesn't respond or attempt to resolve the issue, you can reach out to the outfit that delivered the package. FedEx, UPS, DHL and the USPS allow you to submit a claim for lost, damaged or delayed packages.

Call your credit card company – Most credit cards provide purchase protection, which reimburses you for items that are damaged or stolen, as long as you paid for the item entirely on the card and file the claim within a certain number of days of the purchase. Some high-value items aren't covered, though, and some credit card companies require you to file a police report or insurance claim first.

Talk to your insurance agent – A package stolen from your porch was on your property, so it is covered by your homeowners or rental insurance. However, your deductible applies if you file a claim, as do any limits on certain items.

Tragedies up importance of Move Over law

Not taking precaution leading to deaths of emergency responders

Slow down! And move over! It's a simple request, one that drivers should have no trouble following, particularly as the holiday season approaches. Too often, it's ignored, especially when it comes to roadside-assistance workers.

An average of 24 emergency responders, including tow providers, are struck and killed by vehicles while working at the roadside each year – meaning someone is killed, on average, every other week.

In 2019, 44 emergency responders in the U.S. – including 14 tow-truck drivers – died after being hit as they were working by the roadside.

Startling data from the AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety finds that among drivers who do not comply with Move Over laws, 42% thought this behavior was somewhat or not dangerous to emergency-roadside workers. This demonstrates that drivers may not realize how risky it is for those working or stranded along highways near moving traffic.

To protect these individuals, AAA and other traffic-safety advocates worked tirelessly to get Move Over laws passed in all 50 states and the District of Columbia. Yet, the AAA Foundation finds that nearly a quarter of those surveyed (23%) are unaware of the Move Over law in the state in which they live.

Meanwhile, among those who are

aware of their state's Move Over laws, 15% report not understanding the potential consequences for violating the law.

The cost of fines varies from state to state, but they can be expensive. Penalty points could be added, as well as a misdemeanor charge for failure to move over or slow down when approaching an emergency vehicle, tow truck, utility vehicle or road-maintenance vehicle with

flashing lights on the side of the road.

These tragic accidents extend beyond tow providers and emergency responders. More than 1,600 people have been struck and killed while outside a disabled vehicle since 2015.

Drivers are increasingly distracted while driving. Previous AAA Foundation research found that motorists are as much as four times as likely to crash if they are talking on a cell phone while

driving and eight times as likely to be in a crash if texting.

AAA clubs have participated in educational initiatives regarding Move Over laws by creating public-service announcements and contacting state officials. AAA is committed to raising awareness of Move Over laws and the dangers associated with working at the roadside.

These laws require drivers to move over one lane or slow down when approaching an incident where tow providers, police, firefighters or emergency-medical-service crews are working at the roadside. Many states also have expanded their laws to cover vehicles like utility and municipal fleets, as well as disabled vehicles.

To protect roadside workers, drivers with disabled vehicles and others, AAA offers these precautionary tips:

- Remain alert, avoid distractions and focus on the task of driving.
- Keep an eye out for situations where emergency vehicles, tow trucks, utility-service vehicles or disabled vehicles are stopped on the side of the road.
- When you see these situations, slow down and, if possible, move over one lane and away from the people and vehicles stopped on the side of the road.

Slow down! And move over! It could save a life.

But the most popular vacations I book daily are trips to warm destinations like Mexico, the Caribbean and Costa Rica! This September, I was happy to return to Costa Rica with a coach full of travel professionals to do hotel site inspections. Seeing so many properties first-hand provided invaluable insights when recommending properties to our members.

We flew into Liberia airport and stayed at the Secrets Papagayo Resort – a stunning all-inclusive property with lush gardens on the gulf. The resort is large and hilly with a black-sand beach. It's a great getaway for clients who want an adults-only resort. It's a large spread-out property, not suitable if you have mobility issues. We also toured the nearby

Planet Hollywood, which is an all-ages getaway with a party atmosphere. Farther north, we toured Dreams Las Mareas in popular Guanacaste near the tropical rainforest. Dreams caters to couples and families. Rooms are decorated with natural-wood tones to complement the natural landscape. It was easy to get around and the property had a white-sand beach. My favorite resort experience was watching the loveable monkeys swinging high in the Guanacaste trees. Nearby

activities included whitewater rafting and hiking in the rainforest. Also in Guanacaste is the Westin Reserve Conchal, a golf and tennis resort with a lagoon-style pool. It's a quieter resort and it provides golf carts. The only downside to me was the vendors on the beach, but the shoppers liked it! Next door is the upscale W Hotel Reserva Conchal, with its unique rooms, including the stunning Sunset Treehouse Room, with views of the mangrove forest

from your private balcony! What was my favorite and most unexpected experience? Tamarindo. We toured the Tamarindo Diria – one of the most iconic beach resorts. This charming resort is on Costa Rica's most famous beach, so you can enjoy 1.8 miles of white sand just a few steps from your room. My choice for romance, celebrations and honeymoons is the Casa Chameleon at Las Catalinas. The rooms are spacious with plunge pools and the food is out of this world. They also have a wine cellar. We toured the Mistico Hanging Bridges and did a Jungle cruise, but my sightseeing highlight was seeing Arenal Volcano and the Hot Springs. Arenal Springs Resort and Spa is an active resort with an animal sanctuary, rock-climbing wall, and river for rafting and tubing, along with the hot springs. My overall favorite hot-spring experience was at the Tabacon Thermal Resort and Spa. The hotel was separate from the spring down the road. The property was huge with dozens of pools. My tips for your trip are to bring B.D.P – Bug Spray, Dramamine and Patience. The road infrastructure is winding and some are gravel and rough. It takes longer than expected to get where you are going. And do a guided tour, so your guide can navigate the roads and point out the animals along the way!

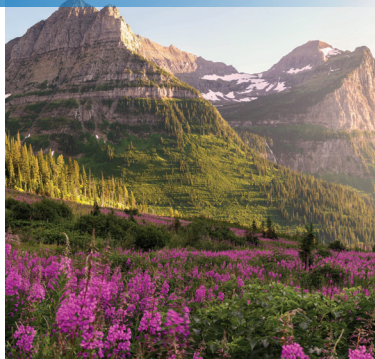

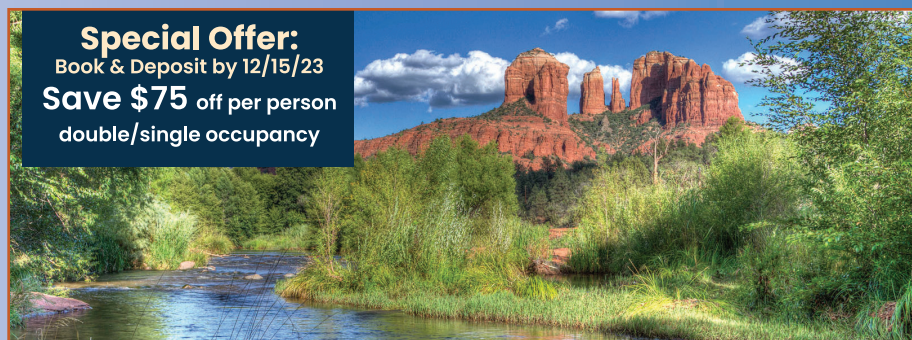

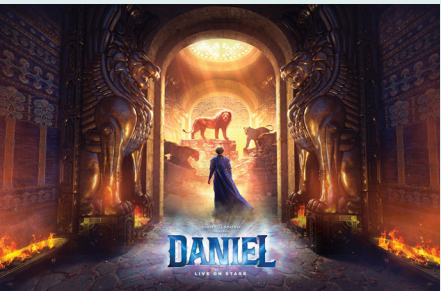

Winter chill can put battery in a bind

It shouldn't be assumed the 2023-24 winter season will be similar to last season's. It's likely snow and colder temperatures could be on the horizon. Frigid wind-chills and icy conditions add to the wear and tear on vehicles, particularly batteries.

Lead-acid batteries' lifespans depend on a variety of factors, but only 30% of new ones will last three years. Batteries must work under temperature extremes and withstand constant shocks and vibrations.

It might seem as if batteries that are used less often should have better lifespans, but that isn't always the case. Batteries could drain more quickly if the car is driven 20 minutes or fewer, causing the battery never to fully charge. Batteries that are deeply discharged or rest idly for long periods of time are more vulnerable to sulfation, a buildup of lead-sulphate crystals, the primary cause of premature-battery failure.

New cars require a steady flow of

electricity to control multiple onboard computers and powertrain features, such as stop-start technology, heated seats, wireless hotspots and video displays that keep the vehicle running smoothly. Reduced hours of daylight result in more use of headlights and heating – all of which take tolls on the battery's power reserve.

The battery should be replaced to help prevent a future roadside

emergency if you notice a dimming of interior lights or a clicking noise when turning over the transmission. Have a trained technician clean the battery cables and check that the electrical system is charging correctly.

Colorado place to go high-plains drifting

Ride the rails to see best of the Centennial State

Colorado is a colorful state. White snowcapped mountains stand tall above vibrant trees and red rocks.

Red enhances Colorado's stately splendor. Even its name comes from the Spanish term for the ruddy stones of the native sandstone. Colorado certainly is special and it has the places to prove it.

Garden of the Gods is home to many of the state's uniquely beautiful sandstone-rock formations. Located outside of Colorado Springs, the solemn red giants, with names like Tower of Babel and Kissing Camels, are set against the backdrop of Pike's Peak.

The Pike's Peak Cog Railway is the world's highest of its kind. It's transported travelers to the rocky pinnacle since 1891. The scenery inspired Katherine Lee Bates to write the lyrics to "America the Beautiful" in 1893. The surroundings include otherworldly rock formations, dense stands of aspen and the rugged peaks of the Continental Divide.

The Royal Gorge Bridge is the world's highest suspension bridge. It hovers 955 feet above the Arkansas River. America's steepest Incline Railway slides 1,500 feet to the canyon floor beneath the bridge. Riders descend inside tiny, two-person cages at a 45-degree angle for the

six-minute trip down to the river.

The southern Rocky Mountains is home to the Cumbres & Toltec Scenic Railroad. Tucked away in a corner, it's mostly unchanged from the day the initial whistle sounded in 1880. The railway is an authentic artifact of the Old West and remains a phenomenal example of the steam era of mountain

railroading.

Clinging to the sheer rock faces, the eight-hour journey climbs more than 10,000 feet up Cumbres Pass. The train snakes along a narrow ledge and from here, the view is to the bottom of the gorge. Later, the grassy hills flatten into a broad plain as the steam locomotive chugs into Antonito, Colorado.

Durango's mountainous topography might only be matched by its colorful past. The Durango & Silverton Narrow Gauge Railroad has been in operation more than a century. Once used to haul gold and silver, the open gondola cars offer vertigo-inducing views along a dizzying series of switchbacks. The narrow gauge 36-inch tracks (standard gauge is 56.5 inches) installed easier around the sharp curves

Traveling through the breathtaking canyons of San Juan National Forest, the steam train takes 3.5 hours to complete the 45-mile route to Silverton, a National Historic Landmark with a fine, Victorian-era downtown.

The Colorado National Monument is located near Grand Junction and preserves one of the grand landscapes of the American West. Towering multi-hued monoliths erupt from rock layers that are nearly 2 billion years old. The canyons are etched deep into sandstone, while pinion pines and junipers crown the high desert plateau.

Rim Rock Drive climbs 2,300 feet, as it circles sheer-sided canyons and enormous rock towers. Workers used picks, shovels and sheer muscle to remove massive amounts of rocks and debris to create the route.
